Do you know about the PACT meetings?

Partners and Communities Together (PACT) gives you the opportunity to influence what happens in your neighbourhood. It is a mechanism whereby neighbourhood issues, identified through local meetings, are taken to a partnership panel, where courses of action are agreed. Members from various agencies take part together with residents. Meetings are held every three months during which three priorities are agreed.
