South Gloucestershire Council

Election of a Town Councillor for Bradley Stoke Town Council, South Ward

1. Forms of nomination for the Town Council Election may be obtained from South Gloucestershire Council, Electoral Registration & Returning Officer, PO Box 1953, Bristol, BS37 0DB from the Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, South Gloucestershire Council, Electoral Registration & Returning Officer, PO Box 1953, Bristol, BS37 0DB on any day after the date of this notice, between the hours of 10am and 4pm, but no later than **4 pm on Friday, 4th February 2022**.
3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 3rd March 2022**.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 15 February 2022. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at South Gloucestershire Council, Electoral Registration & Returning Officer, PO Box 1953, Bristol, BS37 0DB by 5 pm on Wednesday, 16th February 2022.
6. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at South Gloucestershire Council, Electoral Registration & Returning Officer, PO Box 1953, Bristol, BS37 0DB by 5 pm on Wednesday, 23rd February 2022.
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at South Gloucestershire Council, Electoral Registration & Returning Officer, PO Box 1953, Bristol, BS37 0DB by 5 pm on Thursday, 3rd March 2022. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 23rd February 2022. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 23rd February 2022.
